

<u>Cole Foundation Scholarship</u>

Ivy Tech Community College Fort Wayne has partnered with the Olive B. Cole Foundation to offer a new scholarship called the Cole Foundation Scholarship for students living in the four northeastern counties of DeKalb, LaGrange, Noble, and Steuben. The Cole Foundation aims to provide the financial support for students seeking a postsecondary certificate *or* degree while in high school. Students will use dual enrollment-college based dual credit to complete the certification *or* degree. Students who are selected will be awarded the scholarship covering the cost of tuition for the course(s), internet fee (online course), textbooks and the standard technology fee.

Overview:

- Cole Foundation Scholarship is intended for use in programs that fall under the Career and Technical Education umbrella.
- Scholarship funds will cover the cost of the tuition for the course, technology fee, online fee, and any consumable fees including textbooks.
- The course can be face-to-face or online.
- There are limited spots and students should apply immediately.
- Follow the checklist steps.
- Students must obtain school counselor and parent signatures.
- High school transcripts and applicable test score reports must be included in application.
- Students must make sure they meet the pre-requisites for the course they wish to take.
- Students will be contacted by a K-14 Team Dual Credit College Advisor upon selection. Dual Credit College Advisor will schedule an appointment with student to complete course selection process.

Cole Foundation Scholarship Checklist:

Meet with a Dual Credit College Advisor to review scholarship application process, discuss
education plan, and review admission application status.
Complete the scholarship application and obtain parent and school administrator signature.
Submit high school transcripts and/or any copies of PSAT/SAT/ACT score reports to be included in
your Cole Foundation Application.
If applicable submit previously earned dual credit transcripts or AP score reports
