



K-14 Statewide I-Complete Scholarship

The I-Complete Scholarship is available to high school students who are within 2 courses of completing a certification, technical certificate or associate degree at Ivy Tech; a Chancellor may determine if additional courses may be supported through I-Complete Scholarship funding on an individual campus. I-Complete recipients will enroll in dual enrollment (college-based dual credit) courses to complete their certification, certificate or degree. The I-Complete Scholarship can be applied against tuition and fees, including any specific [tuition and program fees](#) during the summer, fall, or spring terms. The scholarship does not include books and supplies.

I-Complete Scholarship Checklist:

- Complete an I-Complete application and obtain school representative and parent/guardian signatures.
- Meet with an Ivy Tech K-14 team member to review scholarship application process, discuss education plan, and review dual credit online application status.
- Submit high school transcript and/or copies of PSAT/SAT/ACT score reports with I-Complete application.
- If applicable**, submit previously-earned dual credit transcripts from other institutions (other than Ivy Tech) and/or Advanced Placement (AP) official score reports.
- Submit application by applicable deadline.

Overview:

- I-Complete Scholarship covers tuition, technology fee, and online fee, if applicable, for a maximum of two courses per completion credential, unless otherwise determined by a campus ITCC Chancellor.
- Courses in-progress count toward student's estimated degree completion audit.
- Students are responsible for textbook and [consumable fees](#), including electronic textbooks, i.e. IncludedED or OER.
- Students may enroll in face-to-face or online sections of the course(s).
- Scholarship funding is limited each semester, therefore, students should apply immediately.
- Students should carefully follow all steps in the application checklist.
- Students must obtain the signatures of their school representative and parent/guardian prior to submitting a completed application.
- High school transcript and applicable test score reports must be submitted with the application, if requested by Ivy Tech K-14 team member.
- Pre-requisites must be met for the proposed course(s) to be completed using the I-Complete Scholarship.
- Students selected to receive the scholarship will receive directions for course registration from a K-14 team member upon selection.
- Scholarship funds will be applied after any other tuition specific aid has been applied to the student's account.
- Scholarships are non-transferrable to any other individual.
- Scholarships have no cash value.
- Scholarships are not transferrable to institutions outside of the Ivy Tech system.
- Scholarship proceeds are not refundable to the student.
- Students may apply for the scholarship for one semester after high school graduation.
- Scholarship must be used within the term that it is offered.
